- **Please correctly enter the student's login credentials to access Interchange and Unified Classroom.** Nebula may automatically lockout students who repeatedly enter incorrect login credentials.
- We have incorporated every aspect of our physical classrooms into Nebula's virtual classrooms.
- Starting from April 12, 2020, DES will hold all virtual classrooms during regular school hours from Sunday through Thursday. Class Schedule/Timetable will be announced later.
- Nebula offers two primary applications for students - **Interchange** and **Unified Classroom**.
- **Interchange** is the student's Learning Management System. Students must visit Interchange to view their virtual classroom for each course. Instructors will post learning content and assignments on Interchange.
- **PowerSchool Unified Classroom** is the student's Classroom Management System. Students must visit Unified Classroom to view their Titan Events Calendar and chat with instructors.
- ITS (Information Technology Services) will publish Nebula video tutorials on DES website and social media channels. These tutorials will help parents and students to easily navigate inside Interchange and Unified Classroom.
- ITS recommend all DES parents and students to use **Google Chrome** as well as have good internet speed for uninterrupted virtual learning.
